

## WHO IS GOD? | EXODUS 34:5-7 | AUGUST 2

THE FOUNDATION OF THE LIFE OF FAITH IS A GROWING KNOWLEDGE OF THE CHARACTER OF GOD.

The defining moment of the Old Testament was the giving of the Ten Commandments.

- 2. What is Moses seeking from God in this second trip up the mountain (Exodus 33:13.18)?
- 3. What does this revelation tell us about the essential nature of God (Exodus 34:6-7)? (see 1 John 4:16; Psalm 34:5-6)
- 4. What does the nature of this revelation suggest about how we come to better know God (Exodus 33:21-23)? (see Psalm 145:3-6)
- 5. What great deeds has God done in your life in the last few years?
- 6. In what ways has your vision of God become fuller in the last few years?
