4. How does the world's view of power and God's view of power differ? (see Mark 10:42-45).
5. Why do so many of us fall short of embracing the high calling of God laid out in this Psalm? (see Colossians 3:8-10; James 1:23-25)
6. How is Jesus a perfect fulfillment of the promise of this Psalm? (see Hebrews 2:5-9)
