- 3. How should the use of money play a central role in our faith (Proverbs 3:9-10; Malachi 3:8-10)?
- 4. Do you regularly give a portion of your money to God's work?
- 5. What does this passage suggest about the relationship between giving and joy (2 Corinthians 8:1-5)?
- 6. If giving is not a tip we give God, but an expression of our dependence and gratitude, how might yours need to change today?
