

SEPTEMBER 27TH / CALLED TO SERVE / GENESIS 1:26-28; 2:19-20 Humankind was created with a distinct purpose to exercise authority and creativity in partnership with God.

The creation of humanity and sabbath rest together form the larger purpose of the creation account. God designed humankind as his living agent to represent him in a world defined by human grasping and the coercive use of power.

- 5. How is God's rest on the seventh day of creation to be reflected in our experience today (Genesis 2:2-3)? (see Matthew 11:28-29; Hebrews 4:9-11)
- 6. What are some ways you can exercise greater Sabbath rest in your life today?
