Jesus identifies His followers as His witnesses. According to Acts 1:1-11, a faithful witness is one who thinks like Jesus, relies on the help He provides, and stays faithful to His call.

#### **READ Acts 1:1-11.**

1. What would you say is Jesus' priority for His followers according to what he says in this passage? (Acts 1:4, 7-8)
2. Some have suggested that the disciples' question in Acts 1:6 shows they don't understand what Jesus' purpose is for the church. What misunderstandings can you see in their question? (John 18:36)
3. In what ways have believers (or the church in general) “lost their way” and not fulfilled Jesus' mandate to take His Good News to people locally, regionally, globally? Why did this happen?
4. What can we do to avoid this error and stay true to Jesus' purpose for us as believers?
5. What is the importance of the help (the Holy Spirit) that Jesus provides in Acts 1:8 to be his witnesses?
6. What are practical ways you could be more intentional in taking the Good News of Jesus to people locally, regionally, and globally?
