In the call of Abraham, we're introduced to God's promise—a central theme in all the Bible. To the childless couple, Abraham and Sarah, God offers a new way of life. Not one built on human potential, but on the promise and power of God.

READ GENESIS 15:1-21.

- 1. Are there promises from God you're waiting on today?
- 2. What are the reasons revealed here for the land promise being delayed (Genesis 15:7, 13-16)?
- 3. What's the point of the sign God gives to Abraham here (Genesis 15:5)? (see Romans 4:20-22)
- 4. Is our faith to be in the promises or in the God who makes the promises? (see Matthew 8:8-10)
- 5. Has God given you a sign of any kind recently about his ability to keep promises in your life?
- 6. What is the meaning of the covenant ritual here (Genesis 15:9-11, 17)? (see Jeremiah 34:18-20)

7. How are God's actions here a demonstration of his unqualified commitment to those he loves? (Romans 8:31-34)
