IS ANYTHING TOO HARD FOR THE LORD?

God first appears to Abram with a promise in Genesis chapter 12. Twenty-four years later

God appears again and puts a date on the promise. The promise of the gospel is not something we easily accommodate to our lives. To believe the gospel is to disbelieve much of what we know to be true about ourselves and the world around us.

Read Genesis 18.1-15; 21.1-7

2. What does this account say to you about your life and your faith today?
3. Does the Lord's question here encourage you or discourage you in terms of your faith (Genesis 18:14)?
4. What is the hardest thing you have ever believed God for?
5. What is the core spiritual truth behind the Lord's actions in Sarah's life here (Genesis 21:1)?
6. When was the last time you experienced this kind of joy in your relationship with God (Genesis 21:6-7)
