

FEBRUARY 28, 2021 / THE GREAT AWAKENING / GENESIS 28:10-17 Only in worship do you come to know yourself and your true calling.

In the book of Genesis, Jacob's life functions on two levels—his conflicts with people and encounters with God. This major encounter with God catches Jacob by surprise and leaves him a changed person. It reminds us that God is present with us and calling us to higher levels of living.

READ GENESIS 28:10-22.

- 1. When was the last time you were genuinely surprised by an encounter with God?
- 2. What is the spiritual truth that this vision of angels conveys (Genesis 28:12)? (see Psalm 139:7-10; Isaiah 41:10)
- 3. Why might Jacob be surprised to hear these blessings from God at this moment in his life (Genesis 28:13-15)? (see Genesis 27:35-36)
- 4. What is the point Jesus is making by referencing this passage to his first disciples (John 1:50-51)? (see John 14:6)
- 5. What is the source of Jacob's newfound courage reflected in his vow in the final verses (Genesis 28:15)? (see Philippians 4:12-13)
- 6. What might you do tomorrow that you are hesitant to do today if you were convinced of God's presence and protection?

God help me to exercise a more courageous faith in my life today.
