- 2. When was the last time that Jesus showed up unexpectedly in your life?
- 3. In what specific ways does Zacchaeus model repentance here (Luke 19:8)?
- 4. How far beyond the Old Testament law does Zacchaeus go in his restitution (Luke 19:8)? (see Leviticus 6:1-5; Numbers 5:5-7)
- 5. What are some simple ways you can begin to exercise a compassionate justice in the world today? (see Luke 3:10-14)

Prayer Point - Holy Spirit open my eyes that I might see opportunities to extend help and grace to those in need around me.
