**FEBRUARY 20, 2022 / THE RESURRECTION / LUKE 24:36-49
IN UNION WITH JESUS, WE TOO CAN LIVE A NEW LIFE.**

WITHOUT THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS, HIS SACRIFICIAL DEATH FAILS TO PROVIDE THE GROUND FOR SALVATION FROM SIN. IT IS A CENTRAL PIECE OF THE GOSPEL THAT MUST BE BELIEVED FOR SOMEONE TO EXPERIENCE THE FULLNESS OF SALVATION AS OUTLINED IN THE SCRIPTURES.

Read Luke 24:36-49.

1. Why is the Resurrection of Jesus central to the Gospel message? (see Romans 6:5-10; 1 Corinthians 15:12-19)
2. What is the relationship between Jesus' resurrected body and our future body? (see Philippians 3:20-21; 1 John 3:2-3).
3. How does it make you feel to know that you will have a body like the one Jesus has here one day? (see 1 Corinthians 15:42-44).
4. How does the Resurrection of Jesus impact our lives today? (see Romans 8:11; Ephesians 3:20).
5. Where do you need a greater experience of Jesus' new life today?
6. How might the promise of a future resurrection for all believers motivate you to share the gospel today?
