

## MARCH 6, 2022 / ETERNITY / REVELATION 21:1-8 ALL PEOPLE WILL SPEND ETERNITY SOMEWHERE.

THE BIBLE IS THE STORY OF GOD'S RESCUE AND RENEWAL OF THE WORLD HE CREATED. IN THE END, HEAVEN AND HELL ARE NOT THE MAIN POINT OF THE BIBLE'S MESSAGE OR DESTINATION. INSTEAD, THE STORY ENDS NOT IN HEAVEN BUT ON A NEW EARTH WHERE LIFE, AS GOD INTENDED, IS FINALLY EXPERIENCED.

1. What is your understanding of eternity?

2. What is the difference between heaven and eternity (Revelation 21:1-4)? (see 2 Corinthians 5:8; Philippians 1:22-24; Luke 23:43)

3. What is the main reason given why people go to hell in the Bible (Revelation 21:8)? (see 2 Thessalonians 1:6-10; Revelation 16:9).

4. What is the most amazing thing said here about eternity (Revelation 21:4)?

5. From what you can learn from this longer description, what will life be like for all of eternity (Revelation 21 & 22)?

6. How might this larger vision shape your living and your priorities today?
