READ Luke 16:1-12.

- 2. What does Jesus say is one of the primary purposes of life in these verses (vs. 10-12)? (see Luke 12.48b; 2 Corinthians 5.10)
- 3. According to this parable what are the 'true riches' being talked about here (v. 11)? (see 2 Peter 3.8-9)
- 4. In what ways can you invest your 'worldly wealth' (money, time, service) to help introduce more people to the message of the gospel today (v. 9)? (see 1 Timothy 6.17-19)
- 5. Are there people whose eternity you are investing in today (time and money)?
