FAITH STORY:

II was born into a deeply-devoted Christian family and we were regularly engaged at the First Presbyterian Church of Asbury Park, New Jersey. I developed a love of God and knowledge of Jesus at an early age, and I consider this a real blessing in my life. I attended Sunday school from my pre-school years through high school (i.e. basic Bible study and memorizing of Bible verses, etc.). We worshipped at regular church services every Sunday. I attended Summer church camps and I completed the Presbyterian "confirmation" and membership class at the age of 13 and became a formal Member of the church. We prayed regularly in our home and our church was always focused on clear and compelling Bible-based teaching and preaching as well as Christian service to the poor and local and global missions. I was also a musician who played piano and organ in various worship services at our church and perhaps a dozen others around the Jersey Shore. This all proved to be a very solid life-long Christian faith foundation. I was baptized as an infant and began taking communion as a teenager (I was also baptized by immersion at Browncroft about ten years ago during our Church on the Lawn worship service and publicly rededicated my life to Christ). When we lived in California beginning in 1990, we found the Menlo Park Presbyterian Church (now known as "Menlo Church"), and it was in this particular season of my adult life (my mid-30's) that a much deeper personal relationship with Christ became the true reality of my life for me. This was a significantly transformative season of deepening focus and conviction on the meaning of Scripture and its personal relevance and impact on all aspects of my life, and eventually through the clear and specific leadings of God's Spirit I responded to the call to service as Deacon, Elder, and eventually full-time vocational work as a minister and pastor. I believe the Truths of the Bible as the journey of my own life has seen God's grace, faithfulness, and mercy bring me through seasons of doubt, trial, loss, and renewal. Jesus is both real and alive to me and is the ultimate treasure of Love to be shared gracefully with all others.

SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES/GIFTS

My most notable Spiritual Gifts are administration, encouragement, leadership, hospitality, teaching and mercy. As God has continued to grow me, I believe the Gifts of wisdom and discernment have been more notably revealed in me. In terms of Spiritual Disciplines, I am a focused and devoted believer and practitioner of personal and group prayer. I am an enthused reader and student of the Bible. I have grown over the past two decades and more to appreciate the benefits and confluence of disciplines where prayer, silence (quiet reflection), and praying the Scriptures work to both center my life on the Person, work and style of Jesus and also enable me to engage in personal and corporate ministry with devotion, energy, patience, and grace.

AREAS OF CURRENT SERVICE

I have just completed three years of service as Chairman of Browncroft's Elder Board. Previously I served full time on our staff for five and half years as Browncroft's Executive Pastor. I was previously elected to the Elder Board in 2013 and served for one year before being elected and hired as Executive Pastor. In addition to my Executive Staff and Board-level work (i.e. Elder Board; executive head of Staff and Programming as XP), I have regularly engaged as a member of the Finance and Facilities Team, Personnel Team, Adult Ministries Team, Reach Initiative Campaign Team, and one year of service as a Missions Team member. I have been devoted to Browncroft's Prayer Ministry, Hospitality Ministry, and Choir as a regular and faithful volunteer for a few years. I have done some teaching and facilitating in our large and small groups (i.e. Married Life leadership of the "Life Keys" Spiritual Gifts assessment class; facilitation in various Membership Classes; etc.).

SAM HUEY

PAST SERVICE EXPERIENCE

During the past 30 years I have served as an elected and ordained Deacon and Elder for eight years at Menlo Church. At Menlo I was also recruited, hired and served for five years on the full-time Pastoral Staff as Minister of Administration and Minister of Congregational Care. I administratively managed a staff of 170 employees and an annual Budget of \$21 million at its peak. In the late 1990's, I was recruited, elected and served for eight years on the Fuller Theological Seminary Board of Trustees (a fully-accredited seminary of 4000 students headquartered in Pasadena, CA and the largest independent Evangelical Christian Seminary in the country). During my Board tenure (the Board comprised some 35 men and women from various professional fields and areas of ministry), the seminary had an annual operating budget of some \$25 million, and we embarked upon and successfully completed a five year \$178 million Capital Campaign, all by God's blessing and grace. In this same season (late 1990's), I was recruited and elected to the Board of Directors of the School of Urban Missions (an accredited two-year Bible College launched in New Orleans, LA with a second campus in Oakland, CA). SUM is a joint venture of two Pentecostal denominations: The Assemblies of God and The Church of God in Christ. In addition to serving on the SUM Board, I worked for two years as an adjunct instructor teaching a comprehensive foundational course on church business administration to our students. While in lay leadership and membership at Menlo for almost twenty years, I "team-taught" a number of large comprehensive Bible Study Courses (i.e. "Bible Bootcamp", a 40 week Genesis through Revelations overview course which gathered for 90 minutes every Sunday morning). At Menlo, I also volunteered and led more than 10 volunteer team short-term missions trips (teams of about 20 people) from Silicon Valley to Juarez Mexico (across from El Paso, TX) to build small churches and pre-fab homes for indigent migrant people coming from southern Mexico to the factory towns along the American border. We led worship services and conducted "Bible story camps" for the young children and families in the "colonias" in the high deserts just south of Juarez (a city of about 1.5 million people). Every trip was a terrific group experience at every level. I was regularly and faithfully devoted to Menlo's significant prayer ministry, including monthly worship services for healing prayer. I also presided over Pastoral Staffers (i.e. four ordained Presbyterian Pastors) who lead our "Recovery Ministry", our "Stephen Ministry" (i.e. we had more than 50 thoroughly trained "Stephen Ministers" who provided weekly "listening and caring" presence to those in need), and our "Friendship Visitation Ministry" comprised of more than 70 regular weekly volunteers who called on the homebound and shut-in both in private residences and in various "caring facilities." And for three years I was a regular weekly, trained and authorized visiting volunteer chaplain at the Palo Alto Veterans Administration Hospital calling on a twenty-bed hospice unit for end-of-life patients and their families within that facility

CAREER INFO

In addition to serving on staff at Browncroft (five and a half years) and Menlo (five years), I have worked through various career chapters primarily as a business executive in the media industry for almost 25 years prior to my time in ministry work. I have managed business units with staffs as large as 250 people with annual revenues of some \$250 million (during the 1980-90's). And I have led much smaller, entrepreneurial and "start-up" business ventures, many of which were very fast moving and enjoyed success or experienced failure. One learns to appreciate risk and accept each kind of unique outcome. We mature. We grow gray hair. I worked for Ziff Davis Publishing Company in NYC and Silicon Valley in the 1980's and 1990's leading and publishing a number of vibrant and profitable media properties (i.e. PC Magazine; MacUser and PC Computing Magazines; Boating Magazine; etc.). I also worked in the Internet media market during the earliest "Dot Com" boom in Silicon Valley and the San Francisco Bay Area in the mid-to-late 1990's and was a senior executive and Vice President of a small venture capital funded start-up that was successfully acquired by Lycos, Inc., a publicly-traded Internet search engine and early social media platform publisher where I served as Senior Vice President before leaving to join Menlo Church in full-time ministry in 1999.
