THE GOSPEL AND RELATIONSHIPS IS PART TWO OF A LARGER STUDY WE BEGAN THIS PAST SEPTEMBER FROM THE BOOK OF 1 CORINTHIANS. WE COVERED 1 CORINTHIANS 1-4 IN A SERIES TITLED SEEING ALL OF LIFE THROUGH THE GOSPEL. THE PRESENT SERIES COVERS 1 CORINTHIANS 5-7. THERE IS NO MORE IMPORTANT PLACE FOR US TO LIVE OUT OUR FAITH THAN IN OUR RELATIONSHIPS. THE CHURCH IS TO BE A HOLY COMMUNITY WITHIN AN UNHOLY WORLD.

READ 1 CORINTHIANS 5:1-13.

- 1. What do you believe are the top reasons most non-Christians hold for not wanting to visit a church?
- 2. What is the Apostle Paul's primary concern in this chapter (1 Corinthians 5:2,6)?
- 3. What is the wrong thinking at the root of this congregation's lax attitude toward sin? (see Romans 3:7-8, Romans 6:1)
- 4. What are the primary dangers for a congregation with a lax attitude toward sin (1 Corinthians 5:6)? (see Matthew 5:13).
- 5. What is the church's most important resource in achieving a greater holiness and witness (1 Corinthians 5:4)? (see Matthew 18.20; Ephesians 3:20)
- 6. How does 1 Corinthians 5:12 challenge the way you see the church and the outside world in terms of living out your faith?

Holy Spirit, help me experience a greater holiness that I may show those around me a transformed life.
