2. What was missing for those with a 'weak conscience' in this passage (1 Corinthians 8:6)? (see Romans 8:33-34)
3. What does the Apostle Paul suggest should be the primary characteristic of the strong or mature Christian (1 Corinthians 8:1b)? (see Romans 15:1-2)
4. What is the primary reason for the caution here about the misuse of one's rights and freedoms as a Christian (1 Corinthians 8:12)? (see Matthew 25:45)
5. In your actions or attitudes, are other believers around you brought closer to Jesus?
