

MARCH 26, 2023 / THE GIFT OF PROPHECY / 1 CORINTHIANS 14:1-40

IN 1 CORINTHIANS 14, PAUL ADDRESSES TWO OF THE 'GREATER GIFTS' EXPERIENCED BY THIS CONGREGATION: TONGUES AND PROPHECY. BOTH GIFTS ARE GIVEN TO THE CHURCH FOR MINISTRY, BUT AN INTERNAL CONTROVERSY DEVELOPED BECAUSE OF HOW THE GIFT OF TONGUES WAS USED. PAUL NOT ONLY ADDRESSES THIS MISUSE BUT STRESSES THE GREATER NEED FOR PROPHECY WITHIN THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH.
