- What do Paul and Silas' actions here say about the nature and quality of their faith (Acts 16:25)? (see 2 Corinthians 12:9)
- How important is it that believers know the Gospel well enough to speak to the needs of the human heart (Acts 16:32)? (see Hebrews 5:11-14)
- What is the clearest indication that this jailer has experienced the Gospel (Acts 16:33-34)?
- In what ways is the Gospel most evident in your life today?
