### Read Matthew 28.16–20; Ephesians 3.20–21

- What does the command 'Go therefore and make disciples of all nations' from Matthew 28:19 mean for us today? (See Acts 1.8).

- What impact do you believe unity among believers from different backgrounds will have on sharing the message of Christ around the world? (see Revelation 7.9–10)
- God promises to be with us always, empowering us to do more than we can imagine. Reflect on any fears or doubts you have about sharing your faith. How does the assurance of God's presence and power change your perspective?
