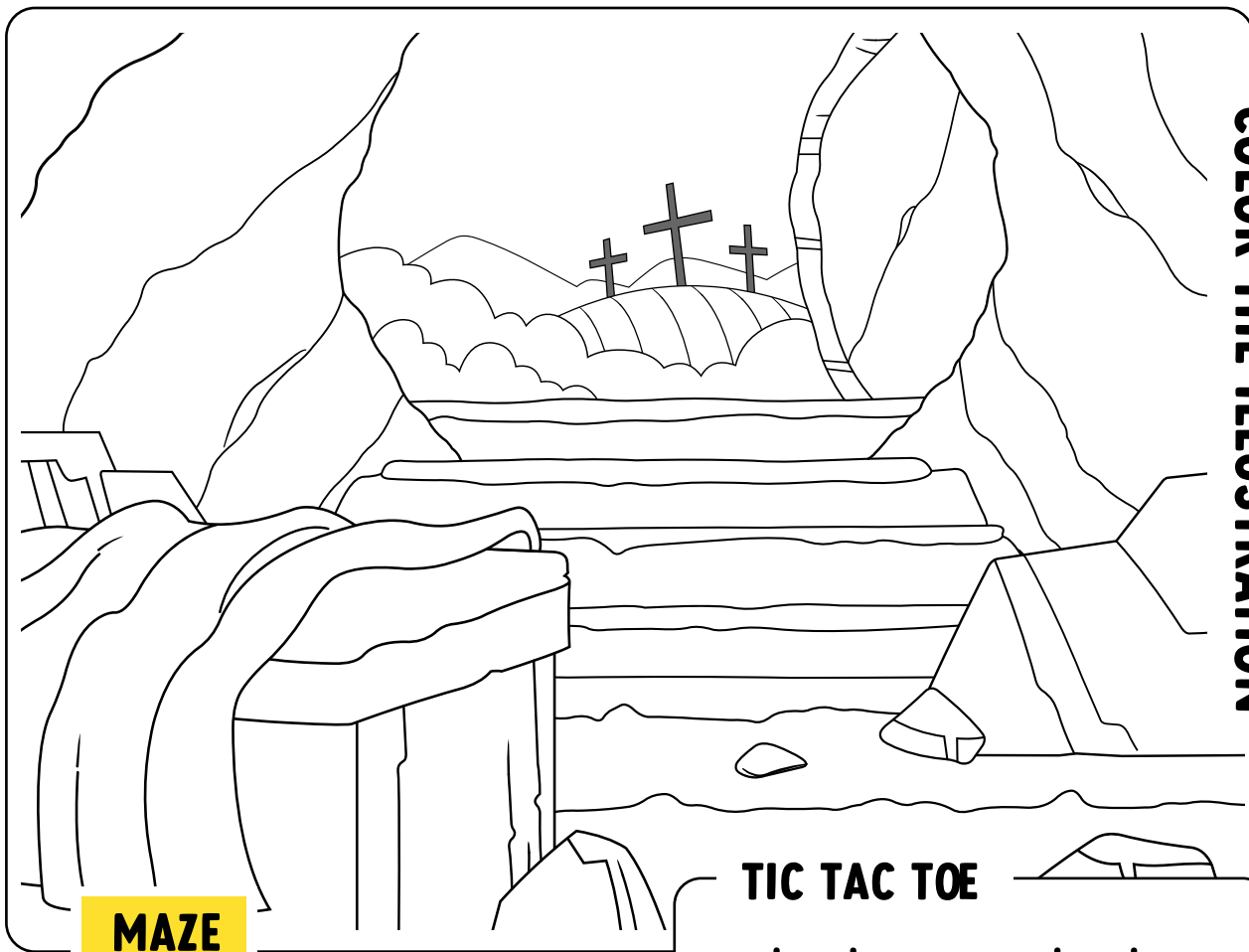
## NAVIGATING A BROKEN WORLD

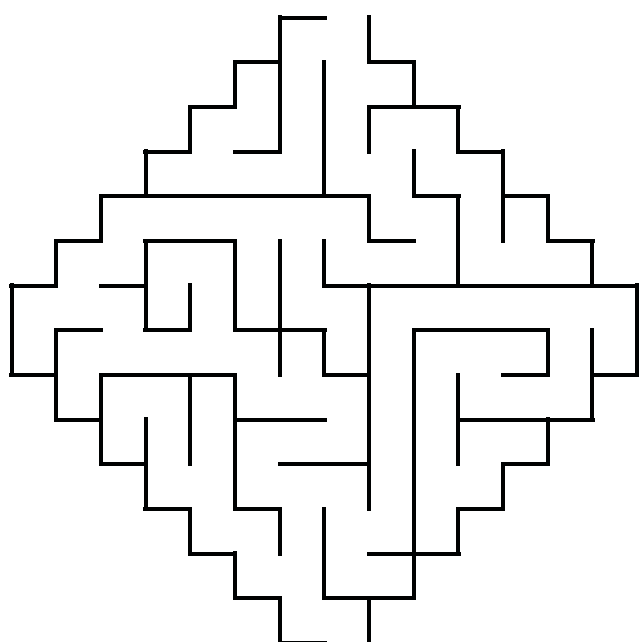
