

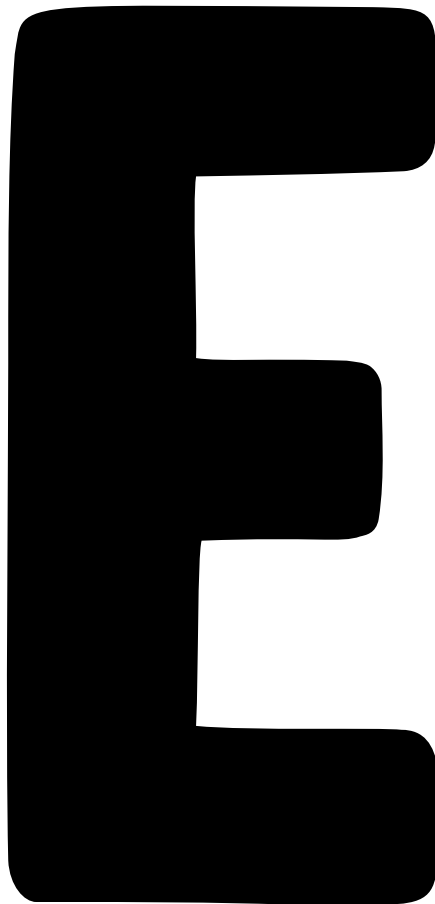

TAKE-HOME

TOWER OF BABEL

(GENESIS 11:1-9) God instructed the people to fill the earth, but instead, they gathered in one spot and built a tower to make a name for themselves. God protected them by confusing their language and scattering them across the earth.

POINT TO JESUS: No one is greater than Him. Because He is great and holy, our sin separates us from Him. We can't do anything on our own to fix that. We can only have a relationship with God when we turn from our sin and trust in Jesus as our Savior.

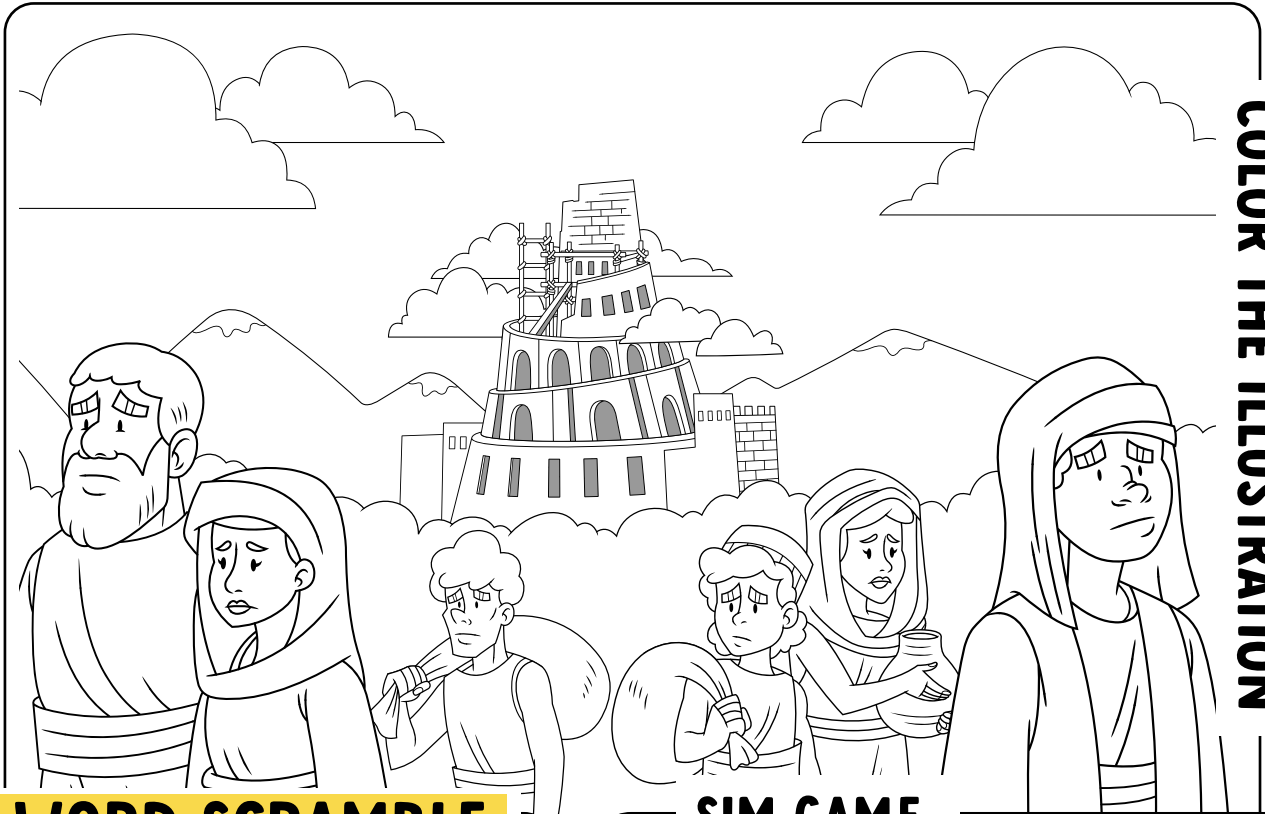
